Rules

1. Culinary, Fancywork, Flowers, Farm & Orchard entries will be accepted Thursday from 1 – 7pm and Friday 7:30am – 10am.
2. Late entries will not be accepted
3. The building will be open on Friday until 6pm
4. Judging will take place on Friday from 11am – 1pm.
5. No one except committee members will be allowed in the building while judging is in progress.

6. Exhibits must be left on display until 3PM Saturday.
7. All exhibits must be checked out by a committee member.
8. There will be a limit of one (1) winning entry per household per division in each section. This mean that only one (1) member of each household will be allowed a monetary prize in each division. More than one (1) exhibit will be accepted, but only one prize awarded. (Example – Flower/Farm & Orchard Section 4, Division: Gourds – One (1) household may enter any number of gourds they wish however, only one (1) of the entries may be awarded a prize.) *Exception for sibling in a household*
9. No new category will be created. There is a miscellaneous division under each section. If you wish to exhibit an item that does not fall into a specific division, it will be placed under the miscellaneous division of the section it best fits.

Culinary Department Rules

1. Exhibits must be baked, prepared and processed by exhibitor during the current year.
2. No food coloring can be used
3. Only those categories listed shall be judged.
4. All foods must be made by exhibitor and displayed on adequate sized, disposable containers.
5. Individual jars of fruit or vegetables will not be judged as an assortment.
6. All jars shall be standard brand with rings in place.
7. Jelly is to be exhibited in glasses/jars that may be opened by judges.
8. Exhibitor agrees that all entries made under the baked goods section are subject to live auction.
9. Prizes of \$5 will be paid for 1st Place and \$3 for 2nd Place.
